SEWAGE / ZONING OFFICER REPORT	- Dingman-Delaware School exceeded parameters again in December;
	 DEP is ready to advertise the new Technical Guidance Policy for septics approved under Act 26. Many of the recommendations of the Citizen's Advisory Committee were incorporated, but raising the limiting zone from 10" to 12" is still part of the Policy. If existing permits for these systems expire, they will not be able to be renewed at the 10" limiting zone.
