#### NONDISCRIMINATION & EQUAL OPPORTUNITY POLICY

Nondiscrimination and equal opportunity are the policy of the Commonwealth and Dingman Township in all its decisions program, and activities. The purpose is to achieve the aims of the United States and Pennsylvania Constitutions. Executive Order 1972-1, the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act, Act of October 27, 1955, (P.L. 744), as amended, (43 P.S.  $\delta$  951, *et. seq.*), and (43 P.S.  $\delta$  153), by assuring that all persons are accorded equal employment opportunity without regard to race, color, religious creed, handicap, ancestry, national origin, age, or sex.

During the term of this contract, the Contractor agrees as follows:

- (a) Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee, applicant for employment, independent contractor or any other person because of race, color, religious creed, ancestry, national origin, age, sex or handicap. Contractor shall take affirmative action to insure that applicants are employed, and that employees or agents are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religious creed, ancestry, national origin, age, sex or handicap. Such affirmative action shall include, but is not limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other *forms* of compensation; and selection *for* training. #### SEXUAL HARASSMENT POLICY
