For applying for a Certificate of Non-Conforming Use

This form is to request a Certificate of Non-Conforming Use for properties in the Lake Adventure Recreational Vehicle Park. That is, vehicles and structures that have been sited/constructed in violation of the Township's Ordinances prior to December 15, 2009 may be provided a form of amnesty for the subject violation and issued a Certificate of Non-Conforming Use.

- 1. Complete the other side of this form.
- 2. Have a Pennsylvania Registered Surveyor survey the property and...
 - a. Locate of set all corner pins.
 - b. Plot on the survey map the location and distance to property lines of the recreational vehicle and all structures, and bodies of water.
