Re: Sewage Permit Applications

Date: September 21, 2015

On July 10, 2013, DEP sent an “All SEO” letter explaining the applicability of Chapter 102 to the On-Lot Sewage Program. DEP also announced that the Sewage Permit Application would be modified to address 102.43. The new applications are starting to circulate in our region, so I wish to bring some information to your attention.

1. You may continue to use up any supplies of the old applications that you may have.
2. There is a new box in Part I of the application. It asks if Chapter 102 Erosion and Sedimentation Permit is required. It also asks if Chapter 102 Erosion and Sedimentation Control Permit has been obtained. The applicant must check these boxes as applicable.
3. If either of the two boxes are checked, appropriate documentation that the approvals have been received must accompany the sewage application. Submission of applications without such proof will result in the application being deemed “incomplete”.
4. DEP did not provide a “not required” box to indicate that not checking the box was an omission. As such, I would recommend that you have the applicant mark it “N/A” and initial next to it.
5. Despite the application box, Dingman Township will still require the proposed disturbed area to be shown on all site plans in which the lot is one acre or larger in size.

6. Questions concerning the applicability of Chapter 102 approvals should be directed to the Pike County Conservation District.
7. In Part III of the application there is a box marked conventional, alternate, experimental, and places to fill in code numbers. Do not complete this section.
